

The PROTECT Project will focus on influencing behavioral changes in vulnerable women, men, adolescent girls and boys in accessing reproductive health services, encourage responsible reproductive health actions and promote zero tolerance for Gender-Based Violence through increasing knowledge and improving attitude and practices.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVE:

The PROTECT project aims to significantly improve family planning and reproductive health of the target municipalities in Camarines Sur by achieving the following outcomes:

- Increase utilization of essential reproductive health services
- Decrease prevalence of teenage pregnancy
- Decrease prevalence of gender-based violence
